URGENT NOTIFICATION

Sub: Regarding computation of INTERMEDIATE Semesters Results & Marksheets of UG/PG Intermediate Semester Examinations 2020

In partial modification of the previous Notification No. BKU/CE/488/2020 dated 07/10/2020, pursuant to UGC Notices / Letters: i) D.O. No. F. 1-1 /2020(Secy) dated 29/04/2020 & ii) D.O. No. F. 1-1 /2020(Secy) dated 06/07/2020, as per resolution adopted in meeting with Principals / TiCs of all affiliated colleges, and as directed, regarding the mode of evaluation of students in all streams, the following procedure(s) shall be used for computation of Intermediate Semesters results of UG & PG Courses:

- 50% weightage be considered on the basis of percentage of marks obtained in previous semester, i.e. UG SEM III for UG SEM IV students, UG SEM I for UG SEM II and PG SEM I for PG SEM II students
- 2. 50% weightage be considered on the basis of the marks already awarded by Examiners for Internal Assessment Tests of Courses / Papers of current semester(s) i.e. UG IV & II and PG SEM II conducted in non-physical contact mode.

This division of the Full Marks of any Course/Paper into 50% & 50% conveys the message that there would be two categories of assessment / evaluation procedures:

- The first would involve awarding of marks arrived at after conducting of Assessment Tests using non-physical contact methods by faculty members concerned.
- The second involves awarding (the student) marks based on previous performance
 / academic record.

Description of computation procedure in detail:

In cases where students may have CNC in one or more Courses in previous semester, thereby having SNC for the entire semester, the calculation of Marks percentage of that semester will be: Total Marks scored in all courses including CNC courses / Full Marks of Semester x 100

For PG SEM II Course 206EF (Non Credit Course) (compulsory for all students), there is no option of Internal Assessment Test and End Semester Examination is of 50 marks. For this Course only, 100% weightage on the basis of percentage of marks obtained in previous semester shall be given and marks calculated.

For PG SEM II Course 205 Internal Assignment:

- If Course Structure has no Internal Assessment and contains only ESE (non Theory
 Course), then marks calculation shall be as per Marks awarded by Examiners
 after Internal Evaluation of Assignments / Term Papers
- If Course Structure has Internal Assessment (10) + ESE (40) (non Theory Course),
 then marks calculation shall be on the basis of 50% weightage to IA Marks
 8 50% weightage to marks percentage of previous semester
- 3. If Course Structure has ESE (50) (Theory Course), then marks calculation shall be on the basis of 100% weightage to percentage of marks obtained in previous semester
- 4. If Course Structure has Internal Assessment (10) + ESE (40) (Theory Course), then marks calculation shall be on the basis of 50% weightage to IA Marks & 50% weightage to marks percentage of previous semester
